**Title of the Practice:** Women- Architect of Society

**Motto:** Safety, Self competency, Self respect

### **Objectives of the Practice:**

- To bring awareness about women rights
- To strengthen girl students by creating awareness about health, nutrition and hygiene
- To develop life skills
- To discover innovative, creative potential and hidden talents in girl students
- To make girl students economically stable
- To explore career opportunities through counseling and personal guidance
- To develop a sense of social and civic responsibilities.

### **The Context:**

Empowerment enables the person to gain insight and to make the person aware of the current situations. The push is needed for a woman in order to develop an attitude of self respect and to know about her capability.

In spite of her exhaustive work and input, woman is deprived of the earnings and getting very meager amount as her returns.

The college admits a large number of girl students. Many of them are the first learners from their family and from low socio-economic classes. “When you educate a girl you educate a nation”, in this context, college instituted Women empowerment i.e. AARYA CELL.

### **The practice:**

The college has instituted AARYA CELL in the academic year 2014. A committee was formed under the leadership of Principal constituting female faculties and representative girl students.

#### **❖ Awareness programs:**

Various awareness programs regarding health, nutrition and hygiene, legal provisions, women trafficking and security, sexual harassment, gender sensitization, career opportunities, voter awareness are conducted. The programs are conducted in various formats like guest lecture, rallies, poster exhibitions.

#### **❖ Education and Training:**

Women self competency is achieved and nourished by organizing guest lectures, workshops, training programs on computer literacy, competitive examination guidance, yoga training, self defense, bottle gardening workshop, bonsai preparing workshops.

#### **❖ Ensuring safety:**

Women need safety from eve teasers, rapists, sexual harassment and violence. Police efforts and making of the laws are not adequate measures to tackle the increasing incidences. Therefore, AARYA Cell trains the girl students for self defense, road safety and even for women trafficking. The college has appointed women security force for security and discipline in the campus.

❖ **Motivational programs:**

Girl students are motivated to explore their hidden talent to participate in Avishkar research festival, rangoli drawing competitions, food carving competitions, mehendi drawing competition, elocution, essay writing, debate competition, singing and other cultural and art work competitions organized by our college and also other colleges. From academic year 2017-2018 Yuvati Mohstav and Miss Dayanand competitions, Dayanand Talent Search Competition, Science Olympiad, Quiz competitions, Mahatma Anand Swami spelling competition, Naitik Pariksha (Dharmshikasha) examination are also organized. Dayanand Shri Award for the outstanding student is given. Girl students are also motivated to participate in Startup India program. The interested girl students are trained to play Nasik specialty drum by our female teaching faculty.

❖ **Socio-economic aid and educational aid:**

- The college has implemented “Dayanand Earn while Learn” from 2016 to support poor and needy students. In 2018-19, nine girl students were benefitted.
- The college offers merit **scholarships** to those students who are economically weak and to those who have lost their parent/s.
- The girl students participated in community work to serve the needy by visiting “Snehalaya” and gifted toys to orphan children. The AARYA CELL on the occasion of Diwali Festival visited ‘Siddheshwar Co-operative Sugar Factory, Solapur and distributed Diwali sweets to the workers who stay away from their home towns in the year 2018-19. The Cell also visited BC girls hostel, Solapur and distributed Diwali sweets on the eve of Diwali Festival in November 2018.

❖ **Grooming of overall personality:**

To develop overall personality of girl students, guest lectures and workshops on career guidance and job opportunity, life skill, spoken English are organized.

❖ **Traditional day programs:**

To keep connected to our culture, values, our origin and to preserve it, the teaching, non-teaching female staff and girl students of the college celebrate Dandiya Mohstav, Nagpanchami, Navratri Utstav, Bhondala.

**Evidence of success:**

The successful organization of the events itself is the evidence of success. Following are the outcomes:

- ❖ Inculcating social welfare in girl students.
- ❖ Becoming social and civic responsible citizen.

- ❖ Enhancement of leadership qualities, life skill, team work spirit.

- Lack of role models in the society to get inspired.
- Overlapping of few theory lectures and practical sessions.
- Reluctance of girl students to stay for long time in college campus.
- Parents of girl students have a fear of violence and insecurity

❖ **Resources required**

- Strengthening the girl students by more involvement of NGO, funding agencies, charity trusts.
- Raising public awareness through voluntary organizations.
- Budgetary provision by University to run various activities
- Parental participation and contribution in higher education.
- Stipend to girl students pursuing higher education like PG and Ph.D. courses.

BEST PRACTICE: 2

**Title of the Practice:** Selfless exercise for deserving students

**Objectives of the practice:**

- To help the deserving students of the college financially to save them from discontinuation of studies due to lack of money or those students who struggle for money to meet their academic expenses
- To support all the topper students without any discrimination of caste, creed or gender
- To financially support Divyang students of the college
- To help students without parents and students with single parents
- To promote equality among students in the campus
- To inculcate the values of sense of social responsibility and generosity among the stakeholders

**The context:**

The students joining to our college are mostly from rural areas from nearby villages. Some students are from economically poor background hence unable to provide them enough financial

support. There are few students whose parents committed suicide as burden of agricultural loans, lack of rainfall etc. In such situation sending their children for higher education becomes day dream. From the students survey it was noticed that many of the students are having single parent mostly only mother who struggles hard to bring them up in education. There are some students who lost both their parents and were struggling with their academic expenses. With the inspiration of the institution's legacy student aid fund is given for industrious students who are unable to pay the fees.

### **The practice:**

A committee has been constituted in the college by the principal to answer above such financial problems of the students. The committee was deciphered as "Scholarship Committee" headed by the Principal. It was decided to extend the scholarship benefit to the deserving students who do not have the advantage of government or any other scholarships. The committee adheres to the rules in selecting the students unbiased.

Few sponsorers deposited money so that interest is given as scholarship.

The notice for the scholarships is published on college Dayanand App, website and college notice board. The committee scrutinizes the applications received from aspirants for the scholarships. Teachers through mentor-mentee also promote in reaching the aspirants. The criteria for the scholarships was decided and named according to their sponsorers.

Mahatma Hansraj Merit Scholarship for Topper students in the Class of B.Sc. I, B.Sc II,, B.Sc. III, B.A-I, B.A-II, B.A.III, B.Sc.-ECS I, B.Sc. ECS II and B.Sc. ECS III by esteemed Alumni Mr. Kishor Chandak. Total 9 students are benefitted.

Shri. Vishnu Yeshwant Gaikwad scholarship is given for Divyang students by the faculty of the college Mr. Shriganesh Gaikwad. Total 7 eligible students were benefitted with this scholarship.

Smt. Kamalabai Shrivallabh Chandak Scholarship is delivered to students who lost both the parents. This scholarship is funded by Mr. Kishor Chandak. Total 11 scholarships were given from the year 2018-19.

Shri. Shrivallabh Lonkaran Chandak Scholarship is delivered to students who have single parent. This scholarship is also funded by Mr. Kishor Chandak. Total 3 scholarships were given.

Shri Mahesh Mahadeo Jagdale Scholarship is given to students who have single parent. This scholarship is also funded by Alumni Dr. Mahadeo Asabe. Total 10 students were benefitted with this scholarship.

Mrs. Manorama Jagdish Naik Scholarship was given to students who have single parent by Shri. Rama Jagdish Mahila Multipurpose Society. Total 9 students fetched this scholarship.

In addition to the above scholarships it is the institutes practice to honour the meritorious students by giving prizes on the annual prize distribution function. In year 2018-19 total 75 prizes has been grabbed by 41 students. These prizes are installed by alumni, staff members, parents, NGO's, etc.

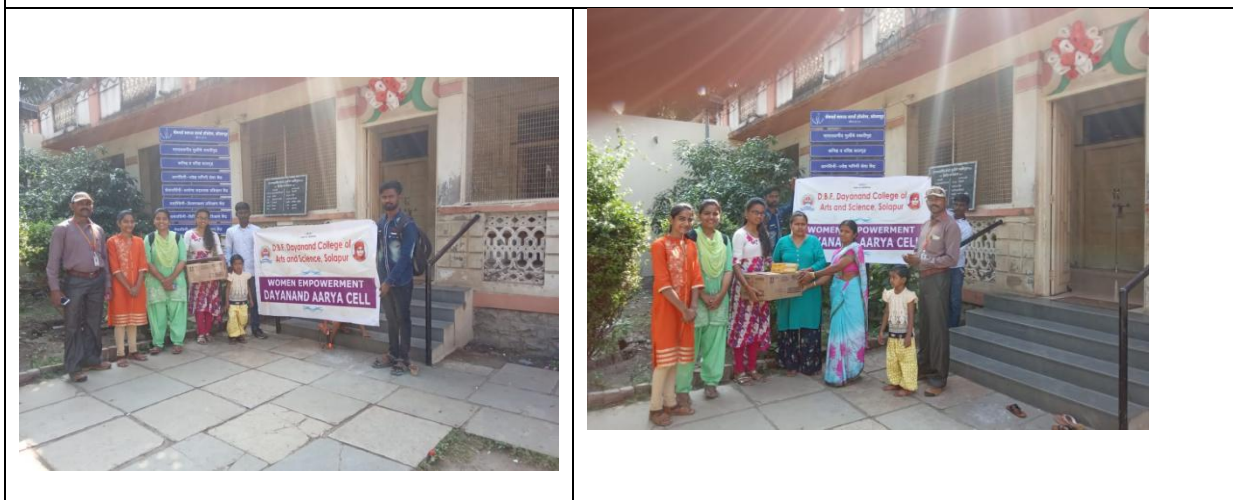
