

Participants: The student satisfaction survey conducted for understanding their satisfaction level covered a total of 292 active students from all classes of regular programs like B.A., B.Sc., B.Sc.(E.C.S.), M.A. and M.Sc.







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Observations of Students Satisfaction Survey on overall performance 2019-20: The Following are the observation on Students Satisfaction Survey feedback on overall performance of institution:

- 1. A good number of students (59.59 %) pointed out that more than 85 % syllabus covered in classes.
- 2. A large number of students' (97.95 %) opinion that the teachers prepare for the classes.
- 3. Majority of students (93.15 %) expressed that teachers able to communicate.
- 4. 78.48 % students opinion that the teacher's approach is best.
- 5. 94.86 % student agreed that fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.
- 6. 79.45 % students expressed that our performance in assignments discussed with them.
