SEASONAL DYNAMICS OF MYORRHIZAE IN SUGARCANE CULTIVARS FROM MARATHWADA REGION OF MAHARASHTRA

ABSTRACT

Present study revealed that the seasonal variations of arbuscular mycorrhizal fungi in different cultivars of sugarcane were studied from five different study sites and correlated with physicochemical analyses. Root colonization was found maximum in winter season among studied cultivars. The maximum root colonization was found in Co86032 (70.91%) while minimum in Co8371 (24.53%) of winter season. Per cent root length colonization was maximum in Co8611 (44.86%) followed by Co86032 (34.53%) in winter while minimum in Co8371 (7.97%) in monsoon. Hyphal, vesicular and arbuscular types of colonization was observed in all cultivars. The highest spore density was observed in cultivar Co740 (867±2.1) followed by Co7114 (823±5.22) in winter season while minimum in Co8611 (266±4.12) in monsoon. The AM fungal spore species diversity was observed in Co740 and Co7114 cultivars. *Acaulospora* and *Glomus* genera were found dominant.

Sugarcane (*Saccharum officinarum* L.) belongs to family Poaceae of the tribe Andropogoneae. It is a tropical crop, grows most successfully in those areas where the climate is more or less tropical, but it can grow in subtropics also. arbuscular mycorrhizal fungal diversity in sugarcane rhizosphere in relation with soil properties has been reported (Datta and Kulkarni, 2012). An *in-vitro* study on sugarcane with respect to VAM fungi was carried (Muniyamma et al., 2000). Soil is the foundation of an agricultural field and mediates processes essential to the functioning of the system, including: biogeochemical cycling of elements such as carbon and other mineral nutrients; provision of habitat for soil organisms; movement, storage, and decontamination of water; and promotion of plant growth (Brady and Weil, 2000). Soil organic Matter (SOM) encompasses living microorganisms as well as plant and animal tissues in various stages of decomposition (Craswell and Lefroy, 2001). Seasonal dynamics of AM fungi in sugarcane (*Saccharum officinarum* L. Cv. Spf-213) in relation to red rot (*Colletotrichum fulcatum*) disease reported from Punjab, Pakistan has noted (Nasim et al., 2008). It was discussed that the mycorrhizal symbiotic status changes the chemical composition of root exudates and fungi serves as a carbon source to rhizosphere microbial communities and further it introduces the physical modifications in the environments surrounding the plant roots (Barea et al., 2002). The growth and development of the plant root probably plays an important role in improving the productivity of sugarcane and root growth in the soil is influenced by various cultural practices, irrigation and fertilizer application, AMF species and cultivars; however its root distribution is affected by physicochemical and biological factors (Gomathi et

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel (the principle which precludes a person from asserting something contrary to what is implied by a previous action or statement of that person or by a previous pertinent judicial determination) or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

4. CLAUSE 4: IMPLEMENTATION METHODOLOGY

4.1 Review committee should be formed consisting of two senior members from each party to set the targets and milestones. Same committee shall take review of the activities, terms of reference and

achievements against set milestones and submit the report semiannually to the WX Consultants Pvt Ltd for recommendation of improvement and betterment of the program.

4.2 The recommendation for modification shall be judged judiciously maintaining the interests of the entities intact and with due considerations to its financial viability and impact.

6. CLAUSE 6: VALIDITY and TERMINATION

6.1 This MOU is valid from **14/02/2022**, This MOU is valid for Three years, both parties agreed that the right to terminate the contract is exercised by any one of us prior notice to the other party.

6.2 Program framework of operation are mentioned in Annexure-I. It shall get reviewed and updated through mutual agreement every year by the review committee at the time of annual review.

6.3 Both parties shall discuss mutually and its scope and framework of "MSME Desk" on aggregable terms of association.

6.4 Either party can terminate the agreement by giving notice of 30 days. Each party shall fulfill all committed financial, non financial

7. CLAUSE 7: COMMERCIALS

8. CLAUSE 8: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES and GOVERNING

8.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent entities, and the relationship established under this MOU shall be specifically for the "MSME Desk" as per the scope mentioned under annexure-I. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

8.2 As professional practice, neither Party is not expected to directly engage, assign work, or recruit other party nominated persons (nominated for conducting any of various Activities under this MOU).

8.3 Governing laws and arbitration: The MOU shall be construed and governed by the laws of India. Any controversy or claim arising out of or divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU or breach thereof shall be resolved/settled by arbitration, to be held in Nashik as in accordance with the rules of the arbitration and conciliation Act 1996

9. CLAUSE 9: TERM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall be effective from the date of execution of this Agreement for conducting Programs from **14/02/2022**.

10. CLAUSE 10: CONSIDERATION:

In consideration of the services rendered as per the terms of this MOU, the commercials shall be shared as per the project.

B) Joint sponsorship for research, innovation and extension:-

1. Party A and Party B agree to investigate ways of identifying and inviting faculty members of each institution to participate in ongoing research or development program of mutual interests. It is anticipated that the terms and the condition for such participation would be worked out by mutual agreement between the faculty members.
2. Further Party A and Party B agree to jointly identify and purpose opportunities for formulation and submission of new research projects, proposal or training program.



2. Further Party A and Party B agree to jointly identify and purpose opportunities for formulation and submission of new research projects, proposal or training program.

C) Exchange of faculty, staff:-

Party A and Party B agree to explore ways of encouraging collaboration between faculty and staff from the two institutions. Specifically the two institutions would encourage members of their faculty to undertake short visit, guest lectures.

D) Students exchange:-

Party A and Party B agree to discuss means for enabling the exchange of students of graduate, post graduate and doctorate level between the two institutions to give from different learning experience.

Further Party A and Party B will explore ways to provide for and facilitate joint guidance of this under their Ph. D. and other graduate degree program.

E) Exchange facilities:-

Party A and Party B will examine the ways of exchanging information on research and educational program and teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research program. Further, both agree to explore ways to share teaching-learning material and other relevant literature. Subject to each institution policy, intellectual property and publication, guidance program for enhancement in infrastructural development.

F) Joint conferences, workshops and short term courses:-

Party A and Party B seek means of identifying and inviting faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation would be worked out by mutual agreement between the invited faculty members and the institution extending such an invitation. Both parties will cooperate in organization of such extracurricular activities.

G) Co-ordination:-

The following agreement is suggested for the co-ordination of collaboration. Each of the institution (Sangola College, Sangola, District – Solapur (M. S.) and D. B. F. Dayanand College of Arts & Science, Solapur, District – Solapur (M.S.)). Shall appoint one member of teaching-learning faculty to co-ordinate the program on its behalf. A coordinating committee will periodically review and identify ways to straighten co-operation between the two institutions.

H) Quality improvement program:-

A continuing quality improvement program to improve quality of teachers at Sangola College, Sangola, District – Solapur (M. S.) and D. B. F. Dayanand College of Arts & Science, Solapur, District – Solapur (M.S.). Through short term and long term certificate courses. Personality development program for enhancement of skill in respect of faculty staff and students providing summer training for the third year students of Sangola College, Sangola, District – Solapur (M. S.) and D. B. F. Dayanand College of Arts & Science, Solapur, District – Solapur (M.S.). The different program regarding employability will jointly be organized so that the students of the both institution will be benefited. E. g. agreement of placement camps, guest lecture of eminent persons, arranging visits, career guidance program. Further coalition would foster the M. O. U. between the institutions. Dayanand College of Arts and Science, Solapur [M.S.] will examine the ways of exchanging information on research and educational program and teaching-learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research program. Further, both agree to explore ways to share teaching-learning material and other relevant literature. Subject to each institution policy, intellectual property and publications, Guidance program for enhancement in infrastructural development.

F) Joint Conferences, Workshops and Short-term courses-

K.A.P. Law College, Pandharpur, Dist. Solapur and Department of Philosophy & Psychology, D.B.F. Dayanand College of Arts and Science, Solapur [M.S.] seek means of identifying and inviting faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation would be worked out by mutual agreement between the invited faculty members and the institution extending such an invitation.

G) Co-ordination-

The following agreement is suggested for the co-ordination of collaboration. Each of the institution (K.A.P. Law College, Pandharpur, Dist. Solapur and Department of Philosophy & Psychology, D.B.F. Dayanand College Of Arts and Science, Solapur [M.S.]) shall appoint one member of the teaching/ learning faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf. A coordinating committee will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

H) Quality Improvement Program-

A continuing quality improvement program to improve quality of teaching staff at K.A.P. Law College, Pandharpur, Dist. Solapur and Department of Philosophy & Psychology, D.B.F. Dayanand College Of Arts and Science, Solapur [M.S.] through short term and long term certificate courses. Personality development program for enhancement of skill in respect of faculty, staff and students. Providing summer training for the third year students of K.A.P. Law College, Pandharpur, Dist. Solapur and Department of Philosophy & Psychology, D.B.F. Dayanand College of Arts and Science, Solapur [M.S.]. The different programs regarding employability will jointly be organized so that the students of the both the institutions will be benefited. e.g. Arrangement of placement camps, guest lectures of eminent persons, arranging visits, career guidance program.

I) This memorandum of understanding is valid for five years i.e. academic year 2021-22 to 2025-26.

Further coalition would foster the MOU between the institutions.




