





1. Title of the Practice: Women- Architect of Society

Motto: Safety, Self-competency, Self-respect for women

2. Objectives of the Practice:

- To bring awareness about women's rights.
- To avail the access, which is denied by the society, in various fields.
- To develop attitude for self-defense and self-security.
- To strengthen lady students by creating awareness about health, nutrition and hygiene.
- To facilitate for acquiring and developing life skills.
- To give exposure to innovative, creative potential and hidden talents in lady students.
- To assist to make lady students economically stable.
- To make them explore career opportunities through counseling and personal guidance.
- To develop a sense of social and civic responsibilities among them.
- To enhance leadership qualities by building a self-confidence.

3. The Context:

Empowerment means "enablement". It also means to enable the person to gain insight and to make the person aware of the current situations. The process involves a change in perception about the self and the surrounding. A push is required for a woman in order to develop an attitude of self-respect and to know about her capability. At many places, in spite of her exhaustive work and input, woman is deprived of the adequate earnings. Most of the times a woman receives very meager amount as her returns against the work done. The college admits a large number of lady students. They come from various backgrounds. Many of them are the first learners from their family and belong to the lower socio-economic classes. It is a duty of the Higher Education Institute to educate them and to empower them. "When you educate a girl, you educate a nation", in this context, the college initiates the Women Empowerment through AARYA CELL, ICC Committee and Vishakha Committee.



4. The practice:

The college has AARYA CELL, ICC Committee and Vishakha Committee since academic year 2014. A committee was formed under the headship of Principal constituting female teaching faculty and representative lady students to run various activities smoothly on the campus to empower Women.

Awareness programs:

Various awareness programs regarding health, nutrition and hygiene, legal provisions, women trafficking and security, women rights, sexual harassment, gender sensitization, career opportunities, voter awareness are conducted. The programs are conducted in various forms like lectures, rallies and poster exhibitions, etc.

Education and Training:

Women self-competency is achieved and nourished by organizing guest lectures, workshops and training programs on computer literacy, competitive examination guidance, yoga training, self-defense training, bottle gardening workshop and bonsai preparing workshops.

Ensuring safety:

Women need safety from eve teasers, rapists, sexually harassers and violence creators. These events are increasing day by day. Police efforts and making of the laws are not adequate measures to tackle the increasing trafficking of women. Therefore, AARYA Cell, ICC Committee and Vishakha Committee train the lady students for self-defense, road safety and even for women trafficking. The college has appointed women security force for security and discipline on the campus.

Motivational programs:

Lady students are motivated to explore their hidden talent to participate in Avishkar research festival, rangoli and drawing competitions, food carving competitions, mehendi drawing competition, clay modeling and craft making, elocution, essay writing, debate competition, singing and other cultural and art work competitions organized by the college and also by other colleges. From academic year 2017-2018 Yuvati Mohstav and Miss Dayanand competitions, Dayanand Talent Search Competition, Science Olympiad, Quiz competitions, Mahatma Anand Swami spelling competition, Naitik Pariksha (Dharmshiksha) examination are also organized. Dayanand Shree Award for the outstanding student is conferred to lady students and they are also motivated to participate in Startup

India program. The interested lady students are trained to play Nasik Drums by our female teaching faculty.

Socio-economic aid and educational aid:

Dayanand Earn while learn scheme:

The college has implemented “Dayanand Earn while Learn” from 2016 to support poor and needy students. During the year 2022-23 five lady students are benefitted.

Scholarships:

The college offers merit scholarships to those lady students, who are economically weak, and to those who have lost their parent/s.

Helping hand program:

The AARYA CELL and alumni of Batch 2010, on the occasion of Diwali Festival visited ‘Siddheshwar Co-operative Sugar Factory, Solapur and distributed Diwali sweets to the ladies workers who stay away from their home town in the year 2022.

The AARYA CELL, ICC Committee and Vishakha Committee in Collaboration with NGO named Aai Pratishtan from Solapur have distributed the Dress materials to selected orphan, single parent, single girl child lady student, economically backward lady students at the hands of Hon. Shree. Mohan Dangare, Secretary, Aai Pratishtan, Solapur.

Grooming of overall personality:

To develop overall personality of lady students, guest lectures and workshops on career guidance and job opportunity, life skill, spoken English are organized.

Traditional day programs:

To keep connected with great Indian culture, values and original aspirations and to preserve them, and also to forget all the chaos of life and to embrace good hopes and to come together, the teaching, non-teaching female staff and female students of the college celebrate Dandiya Mohstava, Nagpanchami, Navratri Utstava and Bhondala.

Felicitation of Women Faculty (Teaching & Non-teaching staff):

The AARYA CELL, ICC Committee and Vishakha Committee on the occasion of “International Women’s Day” from the academic year 2020-21 initiated “Felicitation of Women Staff by offering gifts” as healthy practice as an encouragement for their contribution in the development and progress of college.

Extension Activity has been taken in hand by M. Sc. Part-I Mathematics student Ms. Lamjane Arti Sidram. She is West Zone Chess Player and Hockey State Level Player and has participated in State Level Javelin Throw competition. Problems Encountered:


- Lack of role models in the society to get inspired.



Financial Assistance to Aspirants through Scholarships



Objectives of the practice:

- To help the deserving students of the college financially to save them from discontinuation of studies due to lack of money or those students who struggle for money to meet their academic expenses.
- To support all the topper students without any discrimination of caste, creed or gender.
- Financially support to Divyang students of the college.
- To help students without parents and students with single parents.
- To promote equality among students in the campus.
- To inculcate the values of sense of social responsibility and generosity among the students.

The context:

The students joining the college are mostly from rural areas from nearby villages around Solapur city. Some students belong to economic poor background. Their parents are unable to provide them enough financial support for education. There are few students whose parents have committed suicide due to burden of agricultural loans, lack of rainfall etc. In such situation enrolling their children for higher education becomes a day-dream. When students' profiles are studied, it is noticed that many of the students have lost parents, most of them have only mother who struggles hard to bring them up in educational mainstream. There are few students who have lost both their parents. They are adjusting their living with certain problems such as disorders, cancer, accidents and are struggling for their academic expenses. The student aid fund is availed to industrious students who are economically weak and are unable to pay their educational fees.

The practice:

A committee has been constituted in the college by the principal to address financial problems of the students. The committee is deciphered as "Scholarship Committee" headed by the Principal and IQAC Coordinator and about 10 other members. It is decided to extend the scholarship benefit to the deserving students who do not have the advantage of government or any other scholarships. The committee adheres to the rules in selecting the students unbiased. A few sponsors have deposited an amount of which the interest is rendered as scholarship.

Scholarship Committee meeting is organized biannually for making the policies or determining the criteria for disbursing the scholarship. The committee also discusses about verification and financial aid and review is also taken for the better planning. The college scrutinizes the applications received from aspirants for the scholarships. The notice for scholarships is well published through Dayanand App, College notice board and online portal too. Teachers through mentor-mentee also attempt to reach the scholarship aspirants. The number of donors for scholarships has been increased. Faculty members as well as the alumni also came forward to donate generously. The criteria for the scholarships are decided and named differently.
